Overview

Road Safety GB has announced that the 2023 National Road Safety Conference will be held at the De Vere Cotswold Water Park Hotel on 15-16 November 2023.

As well as being Road Safety GB's flagship event, <u>National Conference</u> is one of the highlights of the road safety calendar. The 2022 edition in Harrogate was the first time the conference has been held since 2019, and once again more then 300 road safety professionals attended across the two days.
